

Feature Article

"Whipcord" 4-strand braid One-person technique

There are so many different braiding and weaving techniques to create strong cords. Fingerloop braiding techniques and lucets are familiar to some people, but for a very portable and endless length of braided cord, I really enjoy this four-strand "whipcord."

You can load the four single strands on to bobbins and hook them overhead. Then grab a partner and throw bobbins back and forth at each other. Duchess Bridget loves to do demos with the two-person bobbin method.

You can also load some small bobbins and attach them to a staff or stick and braid on the go, as seen in this painting from the mid 1600s.



However, Sir Kolfinna taught me another one-person method years again, which I've outlined in this photo essay.

The key phrase is "**Under Two**, **Around the Middle**" and the moving bobbin will alternate as the left-most or right-most bobbin. I hope these photos help you learn this method.

One: Three strands (BCD) are braided on the right and one strand (A) on the left moves next.




One: When I set this down mid-braid, I secure the threads in a comb (or a "fake comb" like this one, made from paper). This helps me see the next moving bobbin and the three that just finished.

Two: Time to use the mantra: "**Under Two**, **Around the Middle.**" The moving bobbin in this case is the left-most one, labeled A.




 $\underline{\text{Two}}$: There is one bobbin to the left, three bobbins to the right

Three: The moving bobbin (A) follows the first half of the mantra, "**Under two**." The moving bobbin (A) is shifted behind/under two bobbins.




<u>Three</u>: Be sure to make that move under/behind B and C. A is now between C and D.

Four: Time to complete the mantra, "**Around the middle**." Since C was the middle thread, A is wrapped around/in front of C. This finishes the move.




Four: Finishing the mantra and finishing all the moves for A

Five: Time to tighten everything up.



<u>Five</u>: B, A, and C are now a set of three strands that look braided together on the left. Tighten them against the full braid above.

Six: Time to start the mantra from the other side of the set.




 $\underline{\operatorname{Six}}$: Everything is tight on the left, which means the right bobbin is hanging out alone and is ready to start to move.

Seven: Start the mantra from the right-side moving bobbin. "**Under two**." The moving bobbin (D) is shifted behind/under two bobbins (C and A).




<u>Seven</u>: Be sure to make that move under/behind C and A. D is now between B and A.

Eight: Time to complete the mantra, "**Around the middle**." Since A was the middle thread, D is wrapped around/in front of A. This finishes the move.



<u>Eight</u>: Finishing the mantra and finishing all the moves for D **Nine**: Time to tighten everything again.




Nine: With everything tightened on the right side, this should look like your very first setup in step one.

With three threads together on the right, you're back at the beginning again. Find the bobbin on the outside left, move it "Under two, Around the middle" and tighten everything up. This leaves one bobbin on the outside right, so once again, "Under two, Around the middle" and tighten.

If you use two dark and two light bobbins of thread or yarn, your finished braid can either have vertical stripes or spirals.

Folks are also welcome to bring their own projects to work on. We will be available for coaching on tablet weaving and spinning.



Opening Comments

Baron and Baroness / Gareth and Alatiel: Let's just get things going, we are looking forward to being able to have in-person at Calle Mayor for September meeting. Would love some more showand-tell from the barony members, maybe to have pizza.

Seneschal / Eilidh: Lots of notes in the meeting agenda.

Officer Reports

Arts and Sciences / Machine and Arwen:

(report sent in, cannot be here tonight) Online A&S classes will be scheduled the third Friday of the month hopefully starting September. We will also have face to face A&S but I am waiting until after Pennsic to confirm days/times. Probably these will be quarterly. I will be working with our Baroness to try to get all garb classes to happen at her open craft nights.

Chatelaine / Guillem: (report sent in, cannot be here tonight) Not much to report from the chatelaine post, although I am working on some flier/brochure stuff

Chronicler / Eilidh: The August Tydes has been published, thank you to those who corresponded with me about permissions and possible upcoming articles. I'd love to see photos from any event when Lyondemere is there. And would anyone like to take some pictures at fighter practices, archery practices, or arts gatherings? Finally, small little doodles would be gratefully appreciated.

Constable / Lupus: not here, no report sent in.

Exchequer / Gabriello: We made some money at the last events, sent checks to Kingdom and Nonmember surcharge (NMS), soon should have the back account updated very soon. New banker here on Wednesday, so wrapping up these things very soon. Should be easy to get the right folks with their signature/Driver's License to a local branch. t.

Herald / Séamus: not here, no report sent in

Marshal (Armored Combat) / Fearghus: Heavy Weapons have been quiet lately, summer doldrums (too hot or people or out and about). Av. 4-5 fighters.

Marshal (Archery) / Emma: (report sent in, cannot be here tonight) Report for archery: Sundays are doing okay, 5 people. Thursdays (Rancho park) are great with 3 to 5 on average (8-10), sometimes more. Often 1 or more newer archers who are just starting out. Response to the email about the arrows still pending.

Miguel made 5 dozen sets of arrows for Rancho and working on loaner gear for El Dorado, and for Altavia and Starkhafn (willing to pay \$50/dz), already got rid of the crappy arrows. Miguel will keep the donated gear and will be willing to sell/donate them. Gabriello looking into earmarked funds, \$47, currently.

Marshal (Rapier Combat) / Sadhbh: (report sent in, cannot be here tonight) Rapier practices are going well, with 4-8 people regularly there including several newcomers. We are in need of some new loaner gear, particularly gorgets and torso protection in L/XL sizes. Webwright / Sadhbh: (report sent in, cannot be here tonight) current Tydes is online (thanks Eilidh!). Let me know ASAP if any officer hasn't gotten into their new email account yet.

Queen's Champion Ranged Weapons July 16:

Total of 46 persons at Gate, 15 adults and 2 youth competed in the archery lists, 3 competed in Thrown Weapons. Queen's Champion for Archery – Guillem Cosinier, Queen's Champion for Thrown Weapons – Quintus Aelius Ajax. Net Income for Event: \$474.00; 40% for Barony - \$189.60, 60% for Kingdom - \$284.40. Delivered the Gate to our Exchequer, and that should be everything.

New Business

Baronial presence at GWW: Garrett has signed up, today is the cutoff for "extra land". Staff contacted us to see if the Barony would like to sign up for shifts at Gate. Very few people going from the barony, might not be able to do this for 2023.
