From the Baron and Baroness

The Baron and Baroness Lyondemere send greetings.

Firstly, please take care of yourselves at out-barony events. We are so used to our beautiful cool sea breezes-and of course not everyone has them so beware the sun.

We would like to address "largesse" in our barony, as some have asked us why we do not present such goodie baskets. At Privy Council with her then Majesty Lorrisa, she said she would like to see the tradition of largesse baskets at every event done away with, and only present for Investitures and Coronation stepping up or more personal gifts for the recipients at those times. The reasoning for this is three-fold. Number one, the making of largesse constantly puts a strain on the populace of a barony and usually only a handful of artisans have the time, funds, or inclination to be able to make the items. Number two, largesse can be any type of gift. Third, many baronies have seen the same baskets with the same items passed around and around over the seasons.

We have decided to adopt Countess Lorrisa's idea, and we have chosen personal gifts from our own funds to give in the name of Lyondemere at Coronation stepping up and Investitures, and they have been well received. We would certainly have the barony process into court with the gifts if our populace would like to do that, at a presentation court, feast, or other event.



We do have some beautiful largesse items that will be used as personal favors at events such as A&S, archery, etc.

Our decision is in no way meant to denigrate those artisans who have spent their precious time making the items we do have or wish to continue making items. Our goal is for our people to enjoy their time in the SCA, not feel under pressure to produce, and to explore the things that make our group so special.



Monday, July 1, 2024 - Attendees: Gareth, Alatiel, Fedelm, John, Sadhbh, Ceallach, Cassandra, Arwen, Guillem, Elidh (10 total)

Zoom Only - Opened at 7:15 PM. Meeting started at 7:30 PM.

Opening Comments

Baron and Baroness / Gareth and Alatiel: Thank you all for working so hard, and we have to do it all again in two weeks for Coronation. Anniversary was such a great event.

Seneschal / Eilidh: I am so grateful for all the everything at Anniversary, including newcomers' attendance, all the thank yous.

Officer Reports

Arts and Sciences / **Machime**: No subject for virtual A&S this month, so taking the month off. Back to it next month. If you have a topic to share, please suggest it. Maybe Arts Champion could do an evening. Alatiel will eventually do a hand sewing class.

Chatelaine / **Guillem**: We had a couple new couples show up at Anniversary, we also had some new members in the FB group, interacting with us before, but now in the group officially. Not much else to report. Plans in the works for replenishing Gold Key with good quality garments. A lot of donations are not usable for our needs. We need small, medium, and large of a few garments. If someone is actually serious about joining, then they can show up and we can make clothes with them. One of the donated items is an embroidery machine, we will auction at some point.

Chronicler / Arwen: The Tydes will be late, but very soon. I would still like to have a deputy slated to take over for me (sooner than later). I may be distracted by some family plans, so I really could use someone in place possibly as soon as September.

Constable / **Lupus**: (not here, no report) Gareth filling in. One green director's chair was left behind.

Exchequer / Gabriello: no official report, tentative numbers for anniversary will be in event section of this meeting.

Herald / Seamus: no report from Seamus, Lachlan will announce names of anniversary champions later in meeting.

Marshal (Armored Combat) / **Fearghus**: proxy report: Fighter practice has been sparse due to fighters being out of town. 3-5 fighters. Lyondemere Anniversary inferno tournament went well with lots of fighting and no injuries! Congratulations to Duke Adam for winning the day.

Marshal (Rapier Combat) / Ceallach: Practices mostly but only 3 most times. Tournament went well. One item of note: the ropes for the erics - we have one long rope maybe not the most efficient way to keep. He'd like to cut the

rope into 40 ft lengths. If that is amenable he'd like to do it. Gyldenholt did it and had some issues with the static length, but cutting in half might work, we also need more eric poles. Gareth has some plans for improvements. Need or organize work parties to make it happen. Can fighters take care of it? More talk at next fighter practice. This Wed will be dark because of holiday on the 4th.

Marshal (Archery) / **Emma**: *proxy report*: Things are going well. No practice this week due to the 4th of July. Next week we'll be set up for royal rounds.

Social Media / Fedelm: Practices are scheduled for online posts. Nothing this week due to holiday.

Webwright / Sadhbh: Website is 95% up to date with practice changes and champion info. New officer listing isn't there yet, nor the email for Ceallach as the rapier marshal.

Old Business

Sat, Jun 29, 2024 — Lyondemere Anniversary - 4 entries in Lyon Bard (and our 21st Lyon Bard is Lady Sadhbh). 25 Rapier participants total: 6 Cut and Thrust, and 19 in heavy rapier (and our champion is Lord Timothy McBride of Aran). 18 participants in the Heavy Weapons lists (and our champion is Duke Adam Makandro). Arts Champion is THLady Rayhana bint Estafanos al-'Abbas. And our winner of the "Best Colors of Lyondemere" winner, THLady Cassandre Nicole Loustaunau. 162 total people through the gate. Current rough total \$2525 from gate, over \$1400 (need final count) from the Aliskye's Estate Sale. Final tally will be published and announced later. We are in good financial shape, just need the bank to change the bank signature cards. Bank issues has been going on for a year. Going to run up to Kingdom. Alatiel - we are going to use another bank, Kingdom is behind us for it.

Sat, Jul 13, 2024 — Coronation - We started to have a few issues with our site, thought it was resolved, then problems came back around again. Arwen consulted with an SCA member who has been Grand Master of several SoCal Lodges, and the lodge is having a Board Meeting tomorrow. They have had problem with this site person in many ways, and so they want to help fix the issue. We should have the issues resolved by tomorrow evening. (Arwen might even be a guest at the BoD meeting and can even pay the remaining balance tomorrow.) Laertes is aware of all the details and Society is ready to issue the insurance as soon as the rest of the site details are solved. Arwen purchased 8 banner pole bases to put up banners. Some of Altavia is loaning some banners, Lyondemere has 1 or 2 to post. Arwen is going to contact Kingdom about what banners they might have. Jamal is also aware of all the site issues, he's on pause but all is well. We have lots of volunteers, we will need some help converting court to dinner. I have a few more to add to the Gate volunteer list, might actually have more than we need. Should have everything solved by tomorrow night.




