From the Baron and Baroness


Salutations to the populace of Lyondemere from Gareth,





MYTH: I CAN ONLY ENTER AS EITHER AN INDIVIDUAL OR AS PART OF A TEAM.

FACT: A person may enter both as an individual and as a team member. A person may also be a member of more than one team.

MYTH: I'M NOT ALLOWED TO GET HELP WITH MY ENTRIES.

FACT: Entrants must do all the work by themselves, but it's perfectly acceptable to take classes, talk to mentors, and ask people to provide feedback on entries and documentation.

MYTH: I HAVE TO WRITE A DISSERTATION FOR MY DOCUMENTATION.

FACT: There are 3 allowable documentation formats: written, audio, and video. The main body of written documentation is limited to 8 pages or 1,250 words. Audio/video documentation is limited to 8 minutes long. See Documentation Guidelines for details.

MYTH: I CAN'T HELP EVALUATE ENTRIES IF I ENTER.

FACT: While it's true that Pentathlon individual and team entrants may not be evaluators, A&S Faire entrants MAY be evaluators for categories they are not competing in.

MYTH: I CAN'T SHARE PROGRESS BECAUSE MY ENTRY HAS TO BE ANONYMOUS.

FACT: Entrants are encouraged to share their projects and progress in any way they see fit. Entrants may include their names on their written documentation if they so choose.

MYTH: ARTS FAIRE & PENTATHLON ARE THE SAME THING.

FACT: An entrant (individual or team) may enter up to 10 entries in the A&S Faire with no more than two in any subcategory. Entrants who submit at least five entries in at least four categories are also eligible to take part in Pentathlon.

MYTH: MY SCORE IS AFFECTED THE DIFFICULTY LEVEL I CHOSE FOR MY ENTRY.

FACT: Entries are scored using a standardized rubric, regardless of whether or not they are entered as beginner, intermediate, or advanced.

MYTH: I HAVE TO BE A MEMBER TO ENTER.

FACT: The Kingdom Arts & Sciences Faire and Pentathlon is open to all who participate in SCA activities of the Kingdom of Caid. SCA membership is <u>not</u> required.
