From the Baron and Baroness


Greetings from Gareth and Alatiel,

Event Reports

Lyondemere Anniversary

Last weekend (*June 14, 2025*) was the 47th Anniversary of the Barony of Lyondemere, which Their Excellencies entrusted me to run for them.

This celebration was held on June 14th, AS LX (or 2025 in the common era), at Calle Mayor Middle School in Torrance, where his Excellency Gareth is known to teach. The site offers easy parking and a large amount of space for us to host activities including tournaments in a variety of combat forms, displays of artistic prowess, merchanting, and plenty of room for a variety of day shades to provide shelter for the visiting royalty (Their Majesties of Caid as well as Their Heirs), our Baronial cousins from Angels, Calafia, Gyldenholt, Nordwache, Altavia, and Dun Or, and as many of the populace of Caid as could be imagined.

The excellent weather I'd ordered came through the day started off cool and overcast, but the sun broke through in the late morning and we stayed in the high 70s thru the end of the day.

We had 166 people attend the event, which was a fantastic turnout given how much else there was going on that Saturday. His Highness said it best when he said they'd come to find an oasis from the darkness in the world, and truth be told, there was an incredible amount of joy to be found at this event.



Opening court featured some very well deserved awards, with Bartholomeous of Lyondemere receiving his Award of Arms from their Majesties of Caid, and both Gideon of Lyondemere and Gabriello de Arexio receiving the Lion's Paw for their service to the Barony of Lyondemere. Immediately after our officer changeover, where Cassandre stepped up as our new A&S officer and Gideon as our new Captain

of the Archers, their Majesties awarded Gideon with the Order of the Chiron. Our own long-standing armored marshal Feargus was given the Order of the Dolphin in recognition of his years of service, and many years were shed as Dame Eilidh was gifted a Pillars of Poseidon medallion from the estate of Mistress Aliskye of blessed memory. Court concluded with the often humorous elevation of Sir Jamal to the order of the Pelican, and we turned to the activities of the day.

This year, Lyondemere was seeking champions in Arts & Science, Armored combat, Rapier, and for the first time, Cut & Thrust. All four competitions brought out some of the best representatives of their arts, and at the end of the day, we were proud to announce our new champions:

- Caterina Sanzio, for Arts & Science
- Adam MacAndrew, for Armored combat
- Colwyn Staghorn, for Rapier combat
- Lyric of Altavia, for Cut & Thrust combat

Also, in a development I hadn't originally planned, we had a very successful silent auction, inspired by Lord Wulfric's generous donation of a pavilion handmade by his father, that his mother Baroness Eva had left with him when she moved. Wulfric operated the silent auction on our behalf, with additional donations from Feargus and Guilliem, who also assisted with the auction during the day.

Additionally, throughout the day, their Excellencies of Lyondemere hosted a charcuterie luncheon for the visiting Royalty and Baronage, provided by the newest recipient of the Lion's Paw, Gabriello. I had the opportunity to partake from their table, and the offerings were fantastic from the homemade smoked salmon to the egg & cheese tarts to the mushroom pate pastries.

Closing court, as it often happens, was short and sweet - fortunately, as the wind was picking up rapidly near the end (at one point depositing one gentle's hat on top of the Baronial pavilion during court). The one big surprise was that Their Majesties had discovered that both our Cut & Thrust champion Lyric, and one of his competitors, Aodhan Crofte, both of whom have been very active in the C&T scene, did not yet have Awards of Arms, which they decided to remedy on the spot (once Crofte could be found and summoned).

We wrapped with the Baron's exhortation to "get off my lawn" and ended the day with much joy.

I would like to offer my heartfelt thanks to everyone who assisted with the day - their Excellencies Gareth and Alatiel for their faith in me, our Seneschal Dame Eilidh at gate, Lord Wulfric and our chatelaine Baron Guillem in the silent auction, our former A&S champion Reyhana and our former A&S officer Machime in the A&S display, Baron Gareth and Sir Dante for the Armored tournament, Lord Ceallach and Lady Cassandre for Rapier and Cut & Thrust tournaments, Baroness Tezar and Dame Theresa for lists, Lord Gabriello for the luncheon, and everyone who helped with everything I'm missing here who made the day run so remarkably smoothly.

LETTERS OF INTENT: Letters of Intent will start being accepted (through an official submission form) on August 23, 2025. There will be at least two virtual (Zoom) optional meetings scheduled in the first few weeks of September for open Q&A with the Crown about Crown Tournament and reigning. Submission of Letters of Intent will close on September 23, 2025.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT: No changes to the standard qualifications. Initial rounds will be round robin in pools. Number of pools and fighters in pools will be determined by the number of entrants. There will be a traditional challenge and the challenge pairs will be grouped into pools. The top two out of each pool will be fed into a double elimination bracket. Ties in the pools will be determined by tie breaker rounds as necessary. Single pass/best two out of three will be determined by the number of entrants. We are looking for the final victor to have roughly 20 passes during the tournament.

Weapons form is fighter's choice, finals are as we initially described, best 3/5.

Round 1: Great Weapon Round 2: Sword and Weapon Round 3: Sword and Shield Round 4: Fighter's choice Round 5: Fighter's choice

There will be rose pick-ups available, similar to Consort's Champion, after pools continuing until semis. All fighters, even those not participating in the tournament, are welcome to join for pickups.

SITE INFORMATION/RESTRICTIONS: This is a dry site. Pavilions and day shades are welcome. Parking will be available onsite. You may drive on the grass to unload, however please do not get your vehicle stuck in the grass when unloading.

Privy Council will be held at the same site, Calle Mayor Middle School, the very next day.



Opening Comments

Baron and Baroness / Gareth and Alatiel: March is very booked for our event attendance. We're going up to the West, Pentathlon, King's Hunt, maybe al-Sahid's Anniversary, Dun Or's Anniversary, so busy! Looking forward to seeing everyone at Arts and Archery on a Saturday!

Seneschal / Eilidh: Ahead of my event report for Consort's Champion Archery, I just want to thank everyone AGAIN for their amazing work to make the event happen. Miguel for all the site setup, targets, and competition fun; the half a dozen folks who brought and setup the pop-ups; Guillem for running out to buy hot coffee to help keep everyone warm; and EVERYONE for one of the fastest pack-outs I've ever seen (as we took advantage of the brief break in rain and sunshine in the sky before rain rolled back in again). Sincerely, this Barony continues to just make me so proud to be part of this community.

- Consort's Ranged Weapons, Sun Jan 26, 2025 Thank you to everyone who came out! We had an amazing "pop-up city" to keep people as dry as possible during the down pour. Their Majesties had a marvelous time. We had a total of 37 people at the event, took in \$495 at gate, covered all our expenses, and with the Kingdom/Barony split of profits (60/40), the Kingdom will take in \$252 and the Barony \$168. The deposit has been delivered to our last exchequer and should be deposited soon. Reports have all been written and submitted. Awards given at the event include: Ceallach mac Uilliam, Harp Argent (bardic); Sadbh ingen Duinn, Harp Argent (bardic); Gideon of Lyondemere, Harp Argent (bardic); Cecilia Medici, Chiron; Miguel de Granada, Furison; Eilidh Swann Stralachlan, Furison; and Seamus mac Neill ui Chonchobhair, Crescent. And His Majesty's champions for the day were named: Amabel Radleigh, Consort's Champion (Archery) and Aidan de Bhal, Consort's Champion (Youth Archery).
- **Arts and Archery, Sat Feb 22, 2025** Guillem, Steward: We're getting ready right now. Fairly simple event, the competitions are mostly pre-set. We'll have setup, the site tokens are ordered and will be prepped. We may have some prizes care of Machime's pottery. Announcements have been posted again around some of the Facebook groups. 

Chatelaine / Guillem: We had a few newcomers attend Arts and Archery to participate, which was exciting. This was their first event in garb. Still would like to make newcomer garb, we have fabric, but we really need someone who can host AND knows how to sew. (working on possible dates for this to happen, AEflaed can help with expertise, Eliane can offer space and machines)

Chronicler / Haldorr: Chronicler doing fine

Constable / Lupus: (not here, no report, no lost and found lately)

Exchequer / Eliane (Kylinne):

- Update status with Wells Fargo: Eliane went to Wells Fargo today and deposited the Gate from Arts and Archery. She was then able to chat with a banker on how to change the account holder. Turns out if she brings the minutes from our business meeting to reflect specific key points, she can bring these documents to the bank and not need our previous key executive on the account to come in with her.
- The bank account is under the official name "SCA Inc., Barony of Lyondemere" (exactly how we indicate any checks can be made out to the barony). We will then direct the bank to change the address from (Tetchubah, in Costa Mesa) to now the legal address for our Exchequer, Eliane (in Westchester). We will remove the former officers on the account (such as Conchobhar, Tetchubah], and others as we find them on the paperwork). We will add to the account: our Exchequer as primary, the Baroness, and our Seneschal [modern details to be updated for the bank copy of the minute]. The assigned "key executive" shall be the Exchequer.
- Discussion of the Baronial Storage Unit: The company will allow "pre-paid for the year" which can be a check from the Barony. Discuss. They provided an invoice for the total for the year.

Herald / Seamus: Thrill a minute. Back to some random travel for work. Please contact him if you'd like to work on names or armory design.

Marshal (Armored Combat) / **Fearghus**: Going well at practice. We've been lucky for fewer rainy Wednesdays. 4-10 fighters at practices. Haven't had non-members in a while. Plenty of loaner gear. Temps have been nice, sometimes foggy. And Daylight savings happens next week.







- We are allowed to comp entries, but it must be published in our "Financial Branch Policy" we might need to research where that gets published.






